




Itinerary

Day 1 - MONDAY 21 MAY PERTH-KALGOORLIE

All aboard the fabulous 'Prospector' as we prepare to depart for the 655km journey to Kalgoorlie. Morning tea is served at your seat as we travel through the scenic **Avon Valley**, and later a light luncheon. On arrival in to Kalgoorlie-Boulder we transfer to our hotel which is situated right opposite the station. There is free time this afternoon before dinner at the hotel.

RAILWAY HOTEL (LD)



to the massive open cut mine with its monstrous machinery known as the '**Super Pit**'. Later we take a guided tour of the beautifully preserved historic **Boulder Town Hall** with its pressed tin ceiling and wrought iron balustrades. Opened on the 23rd of June 1908 it became famous as the host venue for celebrity performers such as **Dame Nellie Melba** and **Eileen Joyce**. The Philip Goatcher painted curtain is the only surviving hanging work of this most famous artist, considered one of Victorian era's greatest scenic painters. After our tour we enjoy a **buffet lunch** at **Sheffields Restaurant** located in the nearby Recreation Hotel. After lunch there is time to visit the museum or relax at our hotel before we transfer to the **Palace Hotel Balcony Restaurant** for our special **farewell dinner** with drinks included.

RAILWAY HOTEL (BLD)

Day 2 - TUESDAY 22 MAY KALGOORLIE - LEONORA - KALGOORLIE

After breakfast we join our road coach for a full day touring the historic Northern Goldfields regions. Our first stop is **Menzies** for morning tea opposite the beautiful stone town hall. We continue to **Leonora** for a brief tour of the town and then visit **Gwalia** to see the **Sons Of Gwalia** super pit. We enjoy lunch at the original Mine Managers residence and visit the old miner's cottages built of corrugated iron and hessian. On our return to Kalgoorlie we stop at the historic **Grand Hotel Kookynie** with perhaps time for a beer and to inspect the old pressed metal ceilings of this once-busy hotel. Further south we detour to the **Niagara Dam**, built to provide water for the steam locomotives during the gold rush period. Late afternoon we arrive back in to Kalgoorlie in time for dinner at the hotel.

Day 3 - WEDNESDAY 23 MAY KALGOORLIE-BOULDER SIGHTS

The two towns of Kalgoorlie & Boulder joined in 1989 to become Australia's largest outback city. *The Golden Mile* as it is known is considered the richest mile of earth, anywhere on the planet and is the major producer of gold in Australia. Our tour today will take us
